This method allows the use of pre-terminated connectors from the patch cord while creating a splicable end for permanent installation. However, it is important to note that testing the bare fiber end before splicing is challenging, and the resulting pigtail may not match the performance of a factory-manufactured pigtail in terms of insertion loss and return loss.

Practical Considerations

- Fiber Type Compatibility:** Ensure the patch cord fiber type (single-mode or multimode) matches the backbone cable to avoid signal degradation.
- Connector Type:** The connector on the patch cord should match the equipment or patch panel requirements.
- Splicing Method:** Fusion splicing is preferred for low-loss, long-term stability, while mechanical splicing can be used for temporary or quick installations.
- Length and Jacket Size:** Pigtails are typically 0.5–2 meters long with thin jackets to fit in splice trays, so the cut patch cord should be trimmed accordingly.
