- SFP Identification:** Single-mode SFPs often have blue markings and operate at 1310 nm, while multi-mode SFPs are usually black and operate at 850 nm.
- Switch Support:** The switch must support the SFP module type. Most modern switches are compatible with both SMF and MMF SFPs, but verification is recommended, especially for third-party modules.
