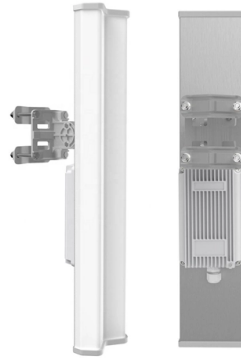


Drilling size for distribution box



AI Overview

The drilling size for a distribution box depends on the cable or conduit diameter, typically slightly larger than the cable or gland size to allow proper fitting and insulation.

General Guidelines

Cable Glands and Conduits: The hole diameter should match the outer diameter of the cable or the size of the cable gland. For example, if using a 25 mm cable gland, the drilled hole should be slightly smaller than the gland body to allow secure installation and sealing.

Drill Bit Selection: Choose a drill bit slightly smaller than the required hole diameter to allow for finishing and proper fitting of the gland or conduit. Control drilling speed to prevent overheating and maintain accuracy.

Mounting Holes: For wall-mounted boxes, mounting holes are typically drilled to accommodate expansion bolts or screws. The bolt length should include the embedded depth, box thickness, and allowance for nuts and washers, plus a small head allowance of about 5 mm.

Debris and Finishing: After drilling, clean all metal shavings and apply rust prevention if the box is metallic. Ensure the drilled holes are smooth and free of burrs to avoid damaging cables.

Practical Example

For a standard LT distribution box with copper bus bars and heavy-duty cable glands, the bottom of the box may require multiple holes of 20–30 mm diameter for cable entry, depending on the cable size and number of feeders. For smaller residential boxes, holes for screws or anchors may be 6–10 mm, while larger industrial boxes may require 25–40 mm for conduit or multi-core cables.

Key Considerations

Always follow manufacturer specifications for hole size and placement. Maintain proper spacing between holes to avoid weakening the box structure. Ensure that drilled holes allow for proper sealing with cable glands to mai...
