Conduit provides mechanical protection for the cable, prevents abrasion, and supports firestop integration at wall penetrations. Common options include EMT (Electrical Metallic Tubing) for indoor or limited-energy applications, which is corrosion-resistant and semi-rigid, or PVC conduit for outdoor use. The conduit diameter should accommodate the cable and connector without excessive force; pre-connectorized cables often require slightly larger conduit or a tapered entry to pass the connector smoothly.

Installation Tips

Pre-cut or pre-bent conduit sleeves can simplify installation through walls or ceilings, maintaining consistent alignment and reducing labor. Lubrication may be used sparingly to ease the connector through long conduit runs, but ensure it is compatible with fiber or dielectric materials. Minimum hole size should match the connector's outer diameter, not just the cable, to prevent damage during threading. Pulling techniques should avoid sharp bends or kinks; use a fish tape or pull string to guide the cable through the conduit. Support and strain r...
