Purpose of Electrical Boxes Electrical boxes, also called junction boxes, enclosures, or outlet boxes, serve as protective housings for electrical connections. All splices and terminations must be made inside an approved box, not buried in walls or ceilings, to comply with safety codes .Types of Electrical Boxes There are four main types of electrical boxes commonly used in residential rooms :Standard rectangular (single-gang or multi-gang) boxes: Used for switches and outlets; single-gang holds one device, multi-gang holds two or more devices side by side.Ceiling or fixture boxes: Round or octagonal boxes designed for ceiling lights or fans; fan-rated boxes are required for ceiling fans.Junction boxes: Provide extra volume for wire splices and connections.Outdoor/weatherproof boxes: Equipped with gaskets and covers to protect against moisture. Boxes can be made of plastic (PVC, fiberglass) or metal (steel). Plastic boxes are lightweight, inexpensive, and nonconductive, while metal boxes are stronger, fire-resistant, and required when using metal conduit or armored cable. All metal boxes must be grounded .Installation Considerations New work vs. retrofit: New work boxes are attached to exposed framing before drywall installation, while cut-in boxes are installed in existing walls by cutting into plaster or drywall .Box capacity: The size of the box must accommodate all wires, devices, and connectors without overcrowding. Single-gang boxes typically range from 18 to 22.5 cubic inches, with larger boxes used for multiple devices or GFCI outlets .Placement: Boxes should be installed at standard...
