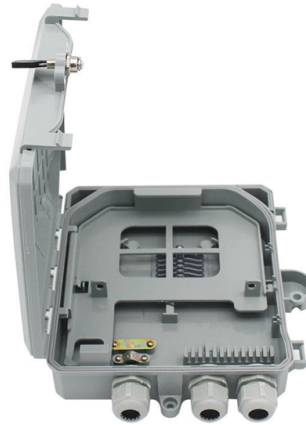

How Fiber Optic Cables Work

Fiber optic cables, also called optical cables, carry data as pulses of light through thin strands of glass or plastic, each thinner than a human hair. The core and cladding layers use total internal reflection to maintain signal integrity over long distances, avoiding the resistance and signal loss that limit copper cables. Unlike copper, which transmits electrical signals, fiber transmits light, enabling much higher speeds and symmetrical upload/download performance.

Types of Fiber Optic Cables

- Single-mode fiber (SMF):** Has a 9-micron core, ideal for long-distance connections, supporting high-speed transmission with minimal attenuation.
- Multimode fiber (MMF):** Larger core (50–62.5 microns), suitable for shorter distances, capable of handling multiple wavelengths simultaneously.
- OM5 fiber:** Supports multiple WDM (wavelength division multiplexing) channels, increasing data throughput for modern data centers.

Speed Capabilities

Commercial fiber networks typically support speeds from 25 Mbps to 100 Gbps, with symmetrical upload and download rates. Laboratory experiments have achieved over 1 petabit per second, and recent research at Aston University demonstrated 301 terabits per second using new wavelength bands (E- and S-bands) with optical processors. These breakthroughs indicate the potential for future ultra-fast networks far beyond current commercial capabilities.

Advantages Over Copper

- Higher bandwidth:** Fiber can carry vastly more data than coaxial or twisted-pair copper cables.
- Lower latency:** Light-based transmission reduces delays, critical for AI, cloud computing, and real-time applications.
- Longer distances:** Signals degrade less over long runs, reducing the need for repeaters.
- Symmetrical speeds:** Upload and download rates are nearly identical, unlike copper networks which are o...
