Maintain the minimum bend radius for all fiber cables to prevent signal loss. Use bend radius control clips or guides inside the cabinet to organize fibers neatly. Route trunk cables to the splicing or adapter panels, ensuring no sharp bends or stress points.
- 4. Fiber Splicing and Termination** For pre-terminated branch fibers or pigtails, connect each fiber to the corresponding adapter panel port, ensuring correct port mapping. Use fusion splicing for bare fibers, protecting them with splice trays or tubes. Terminate connectors at the adapter panel for patching. Label all fibers and ports for easy identification and future maintenance.
- 5. Grounding and Electrical Safety** Properly ground the cabinet to prevent electrical hazards and protect equipment from lightning or static discharge...
