

Fiber Optic Cable Operation Procedure Instructions

Proper handling, installation, and connection of fiber optic cables are essential to prevent damage and ensure optimal network performance. Handling and Safety Fiber optic cables are delicate and can be damaged by excessive pulling, bending, twisting, or crushing. Always follow these precautions: Avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius specified for the cable type, as sharp bends can cause permanent fiber damage and signal loss (attenuation). Do not pinch or squeeze cables; use plastic clamps with large surface areas and apply gentle pressure. Wear safety equipment such as gloves and safety glasses to protect against tiny glass shards. Keep connectors clean to prevent contamination; use optical-grade wipes, swabs, and canned air for cleaning.

Planning and Installation Proper planning ensures a successful installation: Conduct a site survey to identify endpoints, intermediate equipment rooms, and potential obstacles like HVAC ducts or steel beams. Leave 25-40% extra conduit space for future expansion. Follow local building codes and obtain necessary permits. Avoid placing fiber cables near power lines if metallic components are present.

Pulling and Securing Use let-off reels and never leave them unattended during a pull. Maintain pulling tension below the cable's maximum recommended load (e.g., 2700 N for many outdoor cables). Clamp vertical cables at frequent intervals to prevent sagging and movement. For duct or manhole installations, avoid petroleum-based contamination and follow company-specific safety procedures.

Coiling and Bending Coiling should follow a figure-eight pattern for long lengths, with loops 5-8 ft in diameter. Automated coiling machines may exceed design limits; avoid using them for central tube or loose tube cables.
