These systems allow for easy installation and protect the cable strands without affecting optical performance. Breakaway bolts ensure proper torque during installation, reducing the need for specialized tools.
- 3. Aerial Cable Suspension** Aerial suspension clamps are used on straight-line towers to suspend cables along the route. They are pre-formed, often made of aluminum alloy, and include cushioning pads to absorb stress. Variants include low, medium, and high tension clamps, chosen based on the cable type and span length.
- 4. Wall and Surface Mount Clamps** For indoor or confined spaces, fiber optic cables can be secured using:
 - Wall-Mount Clamps:** Attach cables to walls or ceilings.
 - D-Ring Clamps:** Hook around the cable and lock in place, suitable for suspended installations.
 - Surface-Mount Clamps:** Low-profile clamps for floors, walls, or equipment racks.
