

Fiber Optic Cable Upgrade Project in Democratic Republic of Congo



Overview

The Democratic Republic of the Congo's (DRC's) Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Digital Affairs, has partnered with China's Genew Technologies to build a fiber-optic project along the Congo River worth US\$1.20 with Mauritius-based investment firm United Investment LMT (UIL) to strengthen its national digital infrastructure, Congolese media reported. The partnership, first agreed in 2023, is estimated to be worth about \$150 million.
