

Fiber Optic Connection Method for Multiple Routers

- Fiber Transceivers or Media Converters:** Convert optical signals to Ethernet for routers without direct fiber ports. Media converters can also provide electrical isolation and extend connection distances beyond copper Ethernet limits.

Connection Steps

- Install the ONT or Media Converter:** Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet or fiber network to the ONT or transceiver input port. Handle connectors carefully to avoid dirt or damage.
- Link to Router:** Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to connect the ONT or media converter output to the router's WAN or SFP port.
- Power Up Devices:** Turn on the ONT or transceiver first, allowing it to establish a connection with the service provider. Then power on the router and verify connectivity via status lights.
- Configure Router Settings:** Ensure the router recognizes the fiber connection and configure network settings as needed for IP assignment, VLANs, or PPPoE authentication.

Best Practices

- Distance Considerations:** Copper Ethernet is limited to ~100 meters, while fiber can span hundreds of meters to kilometers depending on the type and transceiver used.
- Electrical Isolation:** Media converters provide electrical isolation between the fiber network and the router.
