

Fiber Optic Panel Installation Method

Installing Cassettes and Connectors **Clean Connectors:** Before inserting connectors into module cassettes, clean both the adapters and cable connectors using proper fiber cleaning tools to prevent signal loss.

Insert Cassettes: Slide the module cassettes into the designated drawers until you hear a locking click. Ensure proper orientation to avoid misalignment.

Splice Management: For panels with splice trays, route pigtailed cables into the cable management section and secure them using splice holders or cable ties. Each splice holder can typically accommodate multiple splice protectors.

Cable Handling Avoid sharp bends and excessive tension. Use Aramid yarn reinforcement within cables to minimize stress during pulling or blowing installation. Route cables through guides and organizers to maintain bend radius and prevent damage.

Label all fibers and connectors clearly for future maintenance.
