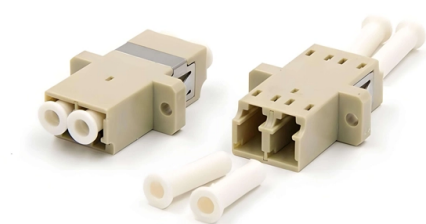


Fiber Optic Patch Cord Model and Model Comparison Table

Jacket and Environmental Considerations

- Indoor:** PVC or LSZH for riser and plenum spaces.
- Outdoor:** OFNR/OFNP, waterproof, or FTTH-rated for direct burial or rooftop installations.

Bend-Insensitive Fiber (G.657A1/A2): Ideal for tight spaces and FTTH applications.

Performance and Application

- Insertion Loss and Return Loss:** High-quality ferrules (zirconia) and precise polishing (UPC/APC) ensure low-loss connections.

Deployment Scenarios

- Intra-rack:** LC duplex or MPO breakout for server-to-switch connections.
