Fiber Optics Overview Fiber optics use thin strands of glass or plastic to transmit data as light pulses. This method allows for high-speed, long-distance communication with minimal signal loss and electromagnetic interference. Light travels through the fiber by total internal reflection, maintaining signal integrity over long distances. Fiber types include single-mode (for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications) and multi-mode (for shorter distances and lower bandwidth) fibers. Transmission distance is influenced by loss (absorption, scattering, leakage) and dispersion (different wavelengths traveling at different speeds).

Optical Modules An optical module, often called an optical transceiver, is a compact device that converts electrical signals into optical signals and vice versa. These modules operate at the physical layer of the OSI model and are essential for connecting network devices like switches, routers, and servers via fiber optic cables.

Key Components

- TOSA (Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly):** Converts electrical signals into light using a laser diode (LD) or LED. It includes a driver chip, optical interface, and monitoring photodiode to maintain consistent output power.
- ROSA (Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly):** Converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals using a photodetector (PIN or avalanche photodiode), a trans-impedance amplifier (TIA), and a post-amplifier to produce a digital signal.
- Supporting Electronics:** Include circuits for signal processing, automatic power control, and digital diagnostic monitoring (DDM) to track parameters like voltage, temperature, and optical power.

Performance Parameters

- Receiver Sensitivity:** Minimum optical power the module can detect without errors.
- Overload Optical Power:** Maximum optical power the receiver can handle before saturation occurs.
- Interface Rate:** Maximum data rate supported, e.g., 1.25 Gbps, 10 Gbps, 40...
