This cable carries the converted data to the router, which then distributes it to devices via wired or wireless connections.

Install the ONT: Place it near the fiber entry point in your home. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port, handling the cable carefully to avoid damage.

Connect ONT to Router: Use a high-quality Ethernet cable to link the ONT's Ethernet port to the router's WAN port. Ensure the router supports gigabit speeds or higher to fully utilize fiber performance.

Power and Configure: Power on both devices, access the router's admin panel, and configure any ISP credentials or Quality of Service (QoS) settings for optimal performance.

Optimize Placement: Position the router centrally for Wi-Fi coverage and update firmware to maintain security and speed.
