A common technique is to lay the cable in a figure-8 pattern during deployment to minimize mechanical stress . For vertical installations, cables should be clamped at frequent intervals to prevent excessive tension and movement . The maximum recommended installation load for most outdoor fiber optic cables is around 2700 N, and exceeding this can damage the cable . Tray-Rated and Environmental Considerations Tray-appropriate fiber optic cables, such as OCC B-series, are designed to withstand crush forces, extreme temperatures, and UV exposure . Jackets may be rated for cold (-50°C) or hot (+85°C) environments, and some are LSZH or riser-rated for flame, smoke, and halogen compliance . Using cables with the correct jacket type ensures long-term durability in the tray environment. Separation from Power Cables When fiber optic cables share a tray with power conductors, conductive armored or metal-clad fiber cables may occupy the same tray with low-voltage circuits (≤ 1000 V), but non-armored cables require a permanent barrier or listed divider to separate them from power conductors .
