Fiber optic cables transmit data as light, allowing high-speed connections over long distances without electromagnetic interference . To integrate fiber into a switch:

For locations without fiber-capable switches, fiber-to-Ethernet media converters can be used to convert the optical signal to copper Ethernet, maintaining electrical isolation and extending reach .
- Practical Considerations** Distance and Environment: Use outdoor-rated fiber if running cables outside or underground. Avoid bending fiber beyond manufacturer limits to prevent signal loss .
- POE Devices:** If powering devices like cameras or access points, ensure the switch supports PoE on the Ethernet output ports .
- Topology:** Fiber links are often used in star or daisy-chain topologies to connect multiple switches across buildings or floors .
