6. Organize and Label: Use cable ties sparingly to organize fibers without compressing them. Label each fiber or port according to network documentation to facilitate troubleshooting and maintenance.
7. Protect Splices and Slack: Place spliced fibers in splice trays or organizers to prevent damage. Store excess fiber in designated slack storage areas, coiling gently...
