Fiber Insertion: Insert the fiber into the ferrule carefully, ensuring proper alignment to avoid signal loss.

Crimping and Securing: Crimp the connector to secure the fiber and provide strain relief.

Polishing: Sequentially polish the fiber end-face using progressively finer films to achieve a smooth, clean surface.

Inspection and Testing: Use a microscope to check for cracks, dirt, or misalignment. Test insertion loss and return loss to ensure performance meets standards (typically
