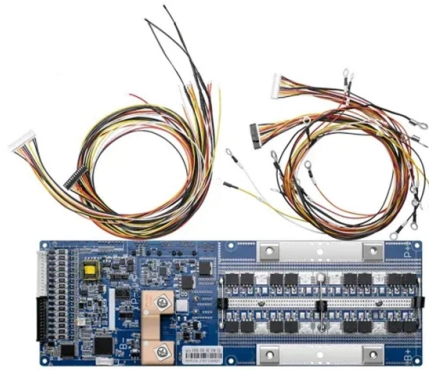


Fiber optic cables are connected using multiple routers

Connect ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's Ethernet port to the router's WAN port. Power On Devices: Turn on the ONT first, wait for status lights to stabilize, then power on the router. Configure Router: Access the router's admin panel via a web browser and enter ISP credentials if required. Update firmware and configure settings like Quality of Service (QoS) for optimal performance. Verify Connection: Check that your devices can access the internet and that the connection is stable. Best Practices Handle Fiber Carefully: Avoid bending the cable beyond its minimum bend...
