- 0.049 in. (1.25 mm) ceramic ferrules for precise alignment and low insertion loss (~0.1 dB per mated pair),
- Duplex or simplex configurations, supporting backbone, horizontal, and work area connections.
- High-density compatibility, doubling port density compared to SC connectors, which is critical for modern 10 GbE, 25 GbE, and higher-speed networks.
- Pre-polished, epoxy-free installation, reducing the need for specialized tools and minimizing field errors.
