Physical Setup Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) The ONT is provided by your ISP and converts the incoming fiber optic light signals into electrical signals your router can use. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated port and power it on. Wait for the status lights to stabilize, usually 2-5 minutes.

Connect the ONT to Your Router Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6 or better) to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Router Placement and Wi-Fi Optimization Place the router centrally in your home for optimal Wi-Fi coverage. For best performance, use a router that supports gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds and modern standards like Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7.

Router Configuration

- PPPoE Settings:** Some fiber connections require a PPPoE username and password to access the internet. These credentials are usually provided by your ISP. If you did not receive them, contact your ISP or check your customer portal.
- Access Number / Connection Identifier:** Certain ISPs may require an access number (Zugangsnummer) or connection identifier. Again, this information comes from your ISP and is necessary for proper router configuration.
- Quality of Service (QoS):** Enable QoS in your router settings if you use VoIP, video conferencing, or gaming to prioritize critical traffic.
- Firmware Updates:** Ensure both your router and ONT firmware are up to date for security and performance improvements.

- Mesh Wi-Fi:** For larger homes, consider adding mesh devices to extend Wi-Fi coverage.
- Wired Connections:** For devices requiring maximum speed and low latency, use Ethernet connections directly from the router.
