Fiber Types

- Single-mode (SM, OS1/OS2):** Core diameter $\sim 8\text{--}10\text{ }\mu\text{m}$, supports long-distance transmission with minimal modal dispersion. Ideal for inter-data center links or long-reach connections.
- Multimode (MM, OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5):** Core diameter $50\text{--}62.5\text{ }\mu\text{m}$, supports multiple light paths, suitable for short-distance intra-data center connections. OM3/OM4/OM5 are optimized for high-speed 40G/100G links.

Rule of thumb: Use single-mode for long reach and multimode for short distances within the same data center.

Connector Types

- LC:** Small form factor, duplex, standard in modern data centers, compatible with QSFP and SFP transceivers.
- SC:** Larger, push-pull connector, mostly legacy, used in FTTH or older networks.
- MPO/MTP:** Multi-fiber connectors (8/12/16/24 fibers), essential for 40G/100G/400G parallel optics.
- MDC/CS:** Next-generation miniature duplex connectors for 400G/800G high-density panels.

Hybrid patch cords (e.g., LC-SC) are used when connecting devices with different port types.

Jacket Types

- PVC:** Standard indoor use, not suitable for air ducts.
- LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen):** Emits minimal smoke and toxic gas, ideal for public spaces and Europe.
- OFNP (Plenum):** Fire-resistant, safe for air-handling spaces.
- OFNR (Riser):** For vertical shafts between floors.
- Armored or outdoor-rated:** For harsh environments or FTTA applications.
