

Fiber optic router location positioning

- Elevated position:** Keep it off the floor, ideally on a shelf or table, away from walls and obstructions.
- Avoid interference:** Keep the router away from metal objects, microwaves, and cordless phones.
- Consider mesh systems:** For homes larger than 1,500 square feet, a mesh network with multiple units ensures consistent coverage.
- Wi-Fi standard:** Use a Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 6E router for best performance with fiber connections; high-end users may consider Wi-Fi 7 for maximum speed.

Step 4: Post-Setup Optimization

- Firmware updates:** Ensure both the ONT and router firmware are current for security and performance.
- Wired connections for critical devices:** Use Ethernet for gaming, video conferencing, or large file transfers to reduce latency.
- Monitor performance:** Test internet speeds and adjust router settings if needed.
- Secure your network:** Change default passwords and enable strong encryption (WPA3 recommended) to protect your Wi-Fi.
