- Busbar and conductor design:** Use copper busbars with tin or nickel plating, recessed conductors, and finger-safe designs to minimize accidental contact and overheating ().

- Arc fault detection:** Installing arc fault detection devices (AFDDs) can prevent fires caused by electrical arcs in low-voltage installations ().
- Compliance with standards:** Follow IEC 60364 and BS 7671 Chapter 42 for protection against thermal effects and fire risks, especially in high-risk locations like wooden buildings or industrial areas ().
- Maintenance and inspection:** Regular inspection ensures early detection of loose connections, dust accumulation, or insulation degradation, which can trigger fires ().
