- Reorganize Wiring:** Arrange wires neatly, using cable ties or modular wiring channels to prevent tangling and facilitate future maintenance.

Testing and Verification After repairs, perform a continuity and insulation resistance test to ensure no short circuits exist. Gradually re-energize the system and monitor for proper operation of all circuits. Check that breakers trip correctly under simulated overload conditions.
