Overview

The French wiring colour system is defined by the NF C 15-100 standard, which aligns with European Harmonisation Document HD 308 S2. In modern installations, Blue represents Neutral, Green and Yellow stripes indicate Earth (ground), and Phase (live). In France, the basic colours used for wiring are typically black, blue, brown, grey, green, purple, yellow, and white. Each colour has a specific meaning and should be followed when wiring and installing electrical systems. In the French wiring colour code, black and blue wires are usually used for. In France, for instance, the standard wiring color code requires that different colors denote different functions, making it important for professionals to be aware of the colors being used. The color-coding system in France is based on the European Union's standards for electrical installation. Nexans started it by putting the bands of colour on the side of R2V cable & it's become an unofficial standard, but there's no requirement to have any colour at all. Thankfully nowadays the actual specification (2X1,5, 3G2,5, 4X6, etc.) is either embossed or printed in white along with the meter. Fortunately, thanks to the European Union there are some common equipment standards, such as cables and equipment carrying the CE mark. The CE mark is a construction stand-ard for equipment. It is also common to find a 3-phase 380v distributed supply in larger properties.
