Maintain maximum distances: sub-distribution boxes should be within 30 meters of the main distribution box, and switch boxes within 3 meters of the equipment they control.

Install boxes in ventilated, dry areas away from harmful media, vibration, heat sources, or liquid splashes, with sufficient space for maintenance and operation.

**Installation and Wiring** Use IP-rated enclosures (minimum IP44 for outdoor sites) to protect against dust and water. Separate power and lighting circuits within distribution boxes to prevent interference and simplify maintenance.

Ensure all internal connections are secure, insulated, and free of exposed live parts. Protective neutral and working zero lines should be properly terminated on separate terminal blocks.

For temporary setups, consider modular portable power cabinets with industrial waterproof connectors to allow safe, flexible relocation as the site evolves.
