- LC (Lucent Connector):** Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for high-density applications. Uses a latch mechanism similar to RJ45 plugs ().
- ST (Straight Tip):** Bayonet-style connector, commonly used in legacy networks.
- FC (Ferrule Connector):** Screw-on type, often used in high-vibration environments.
- MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On):** High-density connectors capable of connecting multiple fibers simultaneously, often used in data centers and industrial networks ().

Performance Considerations

- Insertion loss:** The amount of signal lost when fibers are connected; lower values indicate better performance.
- Return loss:** Measures reflected light; higher values are preferred to reduce interference.
