Core Functions

- Connecting End Devices:** Access switches serve as the first point of contact between end-user devices—such as computers, IP phones, printers, wireless access points, and IoT devices—and the broader network, enabling these devices to communicate with the LAN and beyond.
- Traffic Forwarding and Switching:** Operating primarily at Layer 2 of the OSI model, access switches forward data based on MAC addresses. Many modern access switches also support basic Layer 3 functions, such as static routing, to enhance traffic management.
- VLAN Management:** Access switches organize network traffic by assigning devices to VLANs, which isolates traffic for security and efficiency. This allows separation of different types of traffic, such as guest Wi-Fi and corporate data, within the same physical switch.
- Security Enforcement:** Access switches implement port-based security measures, including 802.1X authentication, access control lists (ACLs), and port security, ensuring that only authorized devices can access the network.
- Power over Ethernet (PoE):** Many access switches provide PoE to power devices like IP phones, wireless access points, and cameras directly through the Ethernet cable, reducing the need for separate power sources.
- Redundancy and Uplink Management:** Access switches connect upstream to distribution or aggregation layers, often using redundant uplinks and link aggregation protocols (e.g., LACP) to ensure resiliency and sufficient bandwidth for growing network demands.
- Local Traffic Optimization:** By handling traffic at the network edge, access switches reduce congestion on higher layers, isolate communication faults, and improve overall network performance.

Access switches are typically deployed in wiring closets, floors, or buildings where end devices are concentrated. They act as aggregation points for both wired...
