Using the Cable Tray as the EGC: In qualifying installations, the metallic tray itself can serve as the grounding path. All tray sections must be electrically continuous and mechanically tight, with bonding at splice points to maintain a reliable path.

Full-Length Grounding Conductor: A continuous grounding wire can be run along the length of the tray, providing a dedicated path for fault currents. This is especially recommended when mechanical connections alone may not ensure electrical continuity.

Bonding Jumpers: Where mechanical connections are insufficient, bonding jumpers should be installed between tray sections. These jumpers maintain electrical continuity and prevent the EGC from being displaced under fault current conditions.

Connection to Building Ground: All cable trays must be securely connected to the building's grounding system, typically via grounding clamps or plated connectors. Tin or zinc-plated connectors are recommended to prevent corrosion, especially in moist environments.

Material Considerations

Copper Wire: Excellent conductivity and corrosion resistance, ideal for critical installations.

Hot-Dip Galvanized Steel: Durable and corrosion-resistant, commonly used in industrial environments.

Stainless Steel: Suitable for harsh or corrosive environments.

Avoid placing bare copper conductors in aluminum trays to prevent electrolytic corrosion; insulated conductors with exposed bonding...
