Fiberglass boxes, for example, are lightweight, durable, and suitable for both indoor and outdoor applications, including transformer pads and sectionalizing cabinets (Oldcastle Infrastructure). Underground or ground-mounted boxes are also available for utility connections, providing secure protection against environmental factors (Hubbell Power Systems). Installation Considerations Placement: Boxes should avoid post-tensioned slab crush zones and maintain proper spacing from tendons and pour joints (IAEI Magazine). Accessibility: Internal components must be accessible for commissioning, operation, and troubleshooting. Ventilation may be required for devices with high heat dissipation (...)
