Mechanical and Environmental Protection: Buried optical cables must resist crushing, bending, and pulling forces during installation and operation. Direct burial methods include plowing, trenching, or duct installation, with careful attention to avoid sharp bends or excessive tension that could degrade optical performance over time. Cables may have armored jackets, polyethylene sheaths, or pipe systems to protect against soil pressure, moisture, and rodents.
