Tertiary Distribution Box: This is the final connection point for individual electrical appliances or household circuits, supplying 220V single-phase power. Each appliance is connected to its own circuit breaker and RCD, following the principle of "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box, one lock." This ensures independent protection for each device and forms the third level of protection.

Protection Principles

The three-level protection system emphasizes leakage protection and residual current devices at multiple levels. The main distribution box and secondary boxes provide upstream protection, while the tertiary box ensures final protection at the appliance level. This prevents a single switch from controlling multiple devices, reducing the risk of electrical hazards.
