The box must be sized to safely handle the total electrical load of the home, including a margin for future expansion.

- Main Switch:** Controls the entire electrical system and allows for emergency shutdown.
- Circuit Breakers:** Protect individual circuits from overload or short circuits. They can be single-pole or double-pole depending on the application.
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs):** Detect leakage currents and prevent electric shocks.
- Bus Bars:** Conductive strips that distribute power from the main breaker to individual circuits.
- Surge Protection Devices (SPD):** Optional devices to protect against voltage spikes.

Safety and Installation Distribution boxes often have IP ratings to indicate protection against dust and water. For example, IP65-rated boxes are dust-tight and protected against water jets, making them suitable for damp areas like kitchens or outdoor installations. Installation typically involves wall mounting, connecting the live (L) and neutral (N) wires, and ensuring proper grounding.
