When cables must cross, do so at 90-degree angles to minimize interference. Future Expansion and Airflow Leave 25-30% spare capacity in cable management systems to accommodate future growth without reorganizing the entire rack. Proper spacing also improves airflow around switches and servers, reducing heat buildup and supporting thermal management for high-power PoE++ devices.
