Thickness and Installation Guidelines

- Slab Penetrations:** Provide 20–30 mm of firestopping material above the tray and install a fire-support plate at the top.
- Waterstop:** At floor-level penetrations, a waterstop of at least 50 mm is recommended to prevent moisture ingress.
- Gap Management:** Ensure all gaps inside and around metal trunking are sealed both internally and externally.
- Inspection:** After installation, inspect for cracks, voids, or incomplete coverage. Fireproof coatings should be uniform, free of bubbles, and meet national fire resistance standards.
