

How much circuit space should be reserved in the distribution box



Overview

Residential electrical panels should have 30-42 circuit spaces for homes under 2,500 square feet and 42-50 spaces for larger properties, with 20-25% reserved for future expansion. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. The. Your circuit count leads directly to the box size. Most homes need: Future-Proofing: Add 20% extra circuit spaces upfront. Future solar panels or EV chargers won't require expensive upgrades. A typical 2,000 square foot home uses 24-30 active.
