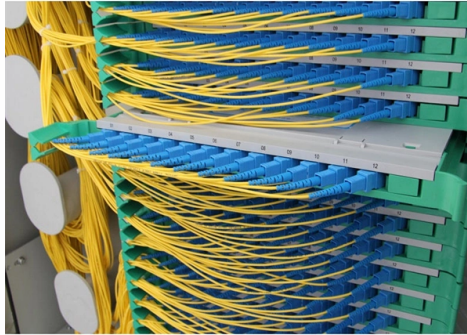

- Firestopping:** Penetrations through walls or slabs should be sealed with fire-rated boards, mineral wool, or firestop packs to prevent fire spread.
