Steps to SSH into the Access Switch

- Obtain the Access Switch's IP Address:** Make sure you know the management IP address of the access switch. This IP should be reachable from your current network location.
- Use an SSH Client to Connect:** Open your terminal or SSH client (like PuTTY) and use the following command to connect: `CodeCopyssh admin@` Replace with the actual IP address of the access switch. You will be prompted to enter the password you configured earlier.

Troubleshooting Connection Issues: If you cannot connect, check the following:

- Ensure the access switch is powered on and connected to the network.
- Verify that your computer is on the same network or that routing is correctly configured to reach the access switch.
- Check for any access control lists (ACLs) that might be blocking SSH traffic.
