4. Labeling and Mapping Each fiber connection should be labeled and mapped to its corresponding port on the patch panel and equipment. This practice simplifies troubleshooting, upgrades, and ensures accurate routing in high-density environments.
5. Separation from Power Cables Fiber cables should be routed separately from power lines to minimize electromagnetic interference and maintain signal integrity. Dedicated pathways or...
