

How to check optical cable specifications

 - LC: Small form-factor, common in high-density networks.
 - SC: Square connector, widely used in telecom.
 - ST: Round, bayonet-type.
 - FC: Ferrule connector, mainly for telecom.
 - MTP/MPO: Multi-fiber push-on, for high-density applications.
4. Physical InspectionDiameter and flexibility: Single-mode fibers are thinner; cable construction (tight-buffered vs. loose-tube) affects flexibility. Check for damage: Cuts, kinks, or abrasions can affect performance.
5. Use Fiber Optic Test ToolsFiber optic identifier: Detects active signals without disrupting transmission. Optical power meter and light source: Measure attenuation and verify performance. OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer): Checks fiber length, loss, and faults.
6. Compare with StandardsEnsure that the cable meets relevant industry standards for your application, such as ITU-T, IEC, or TIA/EIA. Values in datasheets are meaningful only when the test methods and acceptance cr...
