

How to coil 168-wire fiber optic cable onto a reel

- Avoid dropping or tossing the cable; fiber cores are fragile and can break if mishandled.
- Store the coiled cable in a dry, clean environment to prevent contamination or moisture damage.
- Label the cable ends and splices for easy identification during installation or future handling.
