Special Cases Handling: For fibers that are too long or too short, coil them separately at the tray ends. If fibers are shared with special optical devices, place them lightly on ordinary fibers and add a buffer pad to prevent breakage.

Graphic Fiber Discs: Use fiber discs or guides according to the available tray space and remaining fiber length. Coil naturally without pulling hard, ensuring a tidy layout that withstands environmental stress.
