Connect the earth wire from each load to the earth bus bar.

Step 5: Verify Load Distribution and Breaker Size Determine the total electrical load for each circuit to select the correct breaker rating. Use load studies and diversity factors to prevent overloads. Ensure the main breaker can handle the sum of all branch loads. Leave space for future expansion or additional breakers.
