This method reduces field labor and ensures consistent performance, making it ideal for rapid deployment in residential or commercial fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) networks.

Mechanical Splicing Mechanical splicing uses a small connector to align and hold fiber ends together without heat. The fibers are compressed within the splice to create a secure connection. While not as permanent or low-loss as fusion splicing, mechanic...
