Ensure the fiber type (single-mode or multimode) matches the equipment requirements to minimize signal loss.

SC-to-FC Adapter
An adapter or coupler can join an SC connector to an FC connector. The SC connector plugs into the adapter's SC port, and the FC connector screws into the FC port. This method is useful when using existing patch cables or when flexibility is needed for frequent reconnections.

Practical Considerations

Fiber Type Compatibility: Confirm that both ends use the same fiber type (single-mode or multimode) to avoid signal degradation.

Insertion Loss: Hybrid cables and adapters introduce minimal insertion loss, but high-quality components are recommended for critical applications.

Cleaning: Always clean the ferrule ends before connecting to prevent dust contamination, which can significantly affect performance.

Polarity: Ensure proper alignment of transmit and receive channels, especially in duplex connections.
