

How to connect a fiber optic cable to a pigtail patch cord

Mechanical Splicing: Aligns the fibers in a precision sleeve with index-matching gel. Suitable for temporary or field installations.

Splice the Pigtail to the Fiber Align the bare end of the pigtail with the prepared fiber in the splicing machine or mechanical splice holder. Perform the splice according to the equipment instructions. Inspect the splice with an optical microscope or OTDR to ensure minimal loss. Protect the Splice Place the spliced fiber in a splice tray or protective sleeve to prevent mechanical stress. Ensure proper routing inside the Optical Distribution Frame (ODF) or terminal box. Connect the Pigtail to a Patch Cord Plug the factory-terminated connector of the pigtail into the patch panel or adapter. Use a patch cord to connect the pigtail to active equipment such as switches or routers.

Best Practices Match the fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and connector type (LC, SC, ST, FC) between the pigtail and patch cord to avoid compatibility issues. Use factory-polished pigtails to ensure consistent ferrule...
