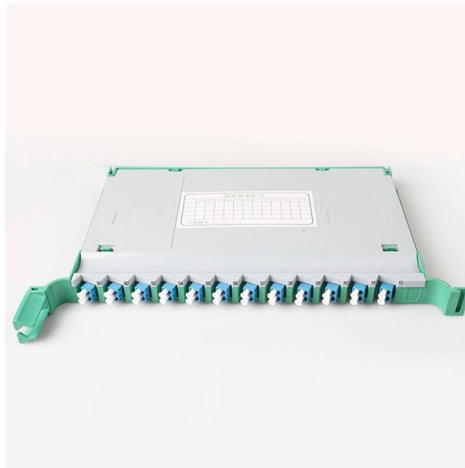


How to connect a fiber optic port

Inspect connectors for cleanliness and ensure all ports meet performance standards. Document the installation for future maintenance and troubleshooting.
