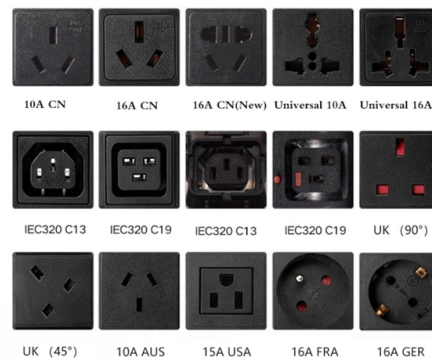


How to connect a full-duplex fiber optic pigtail

Prepare the Pigtail: Ensure the pigtail fibers are clean and free of defects. Check that the "A" and "B" fibers are correctly identified for proper duplex orientation.

Cleave the Fibers: Use a fiber cleaver to make a precise, flat cut on both the pigtail and trunk fibers. Proper cleaving is critical for low-loss fusion splicing.

Fusion Splicing: Place each fiber into the fusion splicer. Align the fibers automatically or manually, then initiate the splice. Repeat for both fibers in the duplex pair. Fusion splicing ensures minimal signal loss and high reliability.

Protect the Splice: Slide a heat-shrink sleeve over the splice and apply heat to secure it. This protects the joint from mechanical stress and environmental factors.
